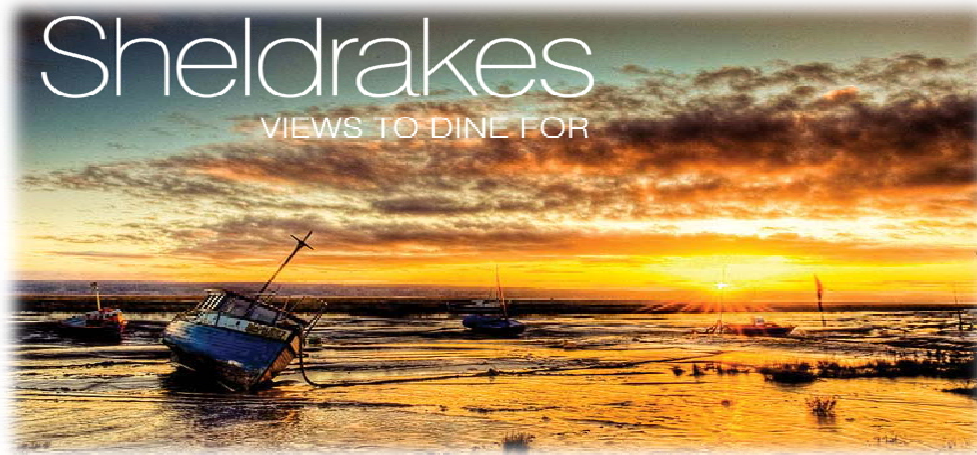
Beck's Blue £2.50 - Identical in every way to its cousin, full flavour, just no alcohol!

VODKA

BLENDED WHISKY

MALT WHISKY

Laphroig 10yr £3.00 - Peaty flavours from the isle of Islay's heathery streams

The Macallan 10yr £3.00 - Soft and malty, with hints of oak and fruit

Balvenie £3.00 - Matured in two barrels to give a flavours of vanilla and nutty cinnamon

Dalwhinnie £3.00 - Soft, yet crisp and dry malt which gives way to deeper citrus flavours

Lagavaulin 10yr old £3.50 - Unmistakeably strong smokey flavour robustly bodied malt

Talisker 10yr £3.25 - A rich dried-fruit sweetness with clouds of smoke and strong barley-malt flavours, warming and intense. Peppery at the back of the mouth.

IRISH WHISKEY

Jamesons £2.75 - Triple distilled and smooth, the premier Irish Whiskey

BOURBON

Bulleit bourbon £3.00 - The hints of oak and spice, the crisp, clean flavour that feels smooth in the throat, the notes of vanilla and honey. The complex taste of Bulleit bourbon is something that can only be appreciated once tried.

SOUR MASH

Jack Daniels £2.50 - Famous Tennessee whiskey needing no introduction

GIN

Tanqueray £2.20 - Juniper, coriander and Angelica make this

Bombay sapphire £2.50 – Passed through a mesh, rather than a traditional copper still for a lighter more floral gin

Hendricks £2.75 – Traditional Juniper along with a hint of Bulgarian rose followed by a mash of cucumber

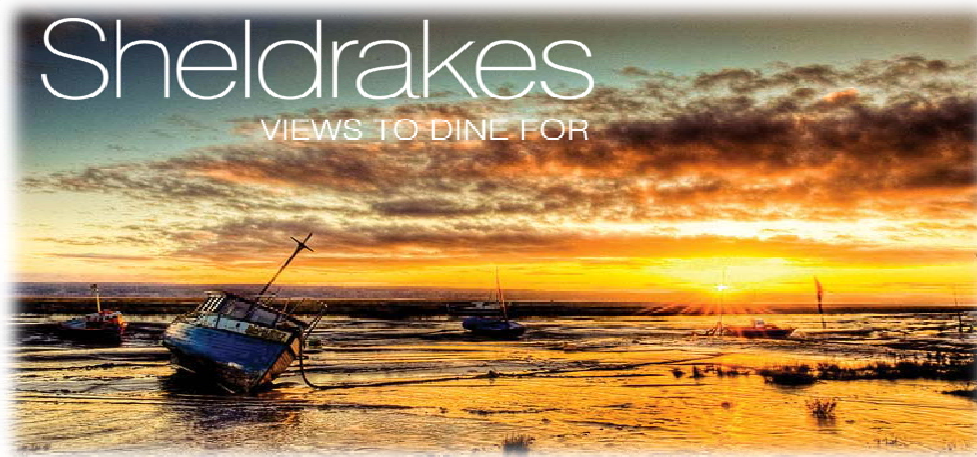

LIQUERS

Amaretto dissaronno £2.50 – Italian sweet almond flavoured liqueur

Gran marnier £2.50 – Made from a blend of true cognacs and the distilled essence of bitter orange

Cointreau £2.50 - Triple sec liqueur produced in Saint-Barthelemy-d'Anjou, France

Crème de cacao £2.20 – Chocolate based liqueur

Tia maria £2.50 – A coffee liqueur made in Jamaica which mixes coffee beans with cane spirit, vanilla and sugar

Baileys Irish cream £2.50 – An Irish whiskey and cream based liqueur

Southern comfort £2.50 – A fruit, spice and whiskey based liqueur produced since 1874 from New Orleans

Benedictine £2.50 – A herbal liqueur invented in 19th century France by Alexandre Legrand. This is a recreation of the drink produced by the monks of the Benedictine Abbey until it's destruction in the French Revolution, containing a blend of 27 plants and spices

Midori £2.50 – A bright green muskmelon flavoured cordial, first concocted in 1978

Archer's peach schnapps £2.50 – A clear, sweet peach flavoured liqueur with a distinctive peach aroma

Calvados £2.50 – An apple brandy from the French region of lower Normandy

Sambucca £2.50 – Developed in Italy, this liqueur contains essential oils obtained from star anise

Cherry sambucca £2.50 – The traditional Italian anise flavours, mixed with cherry

Glayva £2.50 – Made in Leith, Scotland, this is a blend of aged Scotch whiskey's, anise, clove, herbs, heather honey, almonds, tangerine and other citrus fruits. The name is developed from the Gaelic for 'very good'

Drambuie £2.50 – A heather honey flavoured golden whiskey liqueur mixed with a secret blend of herbs and spices, produced in West Lothian, Scotland

Tequila gold £2.50 – A blue agave based spirit made primarily in western Mexico since the 16th century

Martini; Dry / Bianco / Rosso £2.20 – An Italian vermouth, made since 1863 from wine, botanicals and sugar
